

Teens and the Vaccine

If you have a 12 to 17 year old, he or she is now eligible to get the COVID-19 vaccine.

Not just your teens, but all Washingtonians age 12+ are eligible.

Currently Pfizer-BioNTech is the only vaccine authorized for 12 to 17-year-olds.

Your teen will need consent from a parent or guardian to get the vaccine.

Those ages 12 to 17 may need consent from a parent or guardian, unless they are legally emancipated. It is recommended to ask the vaccine provider what they require.
